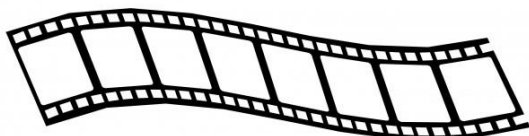
Parents are invited to visit our student art gallery featuring Mi'kmaq artwork on Friday, November 3 from 7:45 am to 8:30 am in the gym.
