Primary Registration for 2017-2018

If you have a child or know of others who live in our school area and will be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2018, **please call the school to book an appointment.** Registration will be held Monday, February 5, 2018. At that time you and your child will complete registration forms as well as visit with the public health nurses for vision screening and oral health assessments. Please bring your child's birth certificate, health card and proof of residency.

School Cancellations/Early Dismissals

In the event of inclement weather, please check ccrsb.ca for the most up to date information. These are the possible options that happen when we hear about pending stormy weather:

- **Schools open** and buses run as usual – on CCRSB website by 6:30am
- **Buses** operate on **paved roads only** – on CCRSB website by 6:30am and alert email to parents
- **Early dismissal (by one hour or two hours)** – on CCRSB website by 6:30am and alert email to parents
- **Mid-day closures** are very uncommon but could happen as a result of power outages – on CCRSB website when decision is made, alert email to parents and communication system in place to contact to all families
- **School is closed** – on CCRSB website by 6:30am
